The use of ALBOX textile boxes is widespread in Australia including the National Gallery. Design changes made possible by the introduction of polypropylene have enabled the development of stronger, water resistant and fully archival boxes. There are two sizes available plus an extension kit for the larger box that was developed with the assistance of Artlab. But the use of these boxes is not restricted to archives. Many expensive bridal gowns are now in safe keeping in these storage boxes.

Codes/Sizes are:

**Small Textile Box**

SMTEXTILE – 800 x 540 x 140mm

**Large Textile**

TEXTILE – 1350 x 540 x 140mm

**Large Textile Box Extension**

TEXTILE EXT – Increases  
box up to 2 metres long



A special box has also been designed for the long term storage of hats but, of course, it can also be used for other textile items, small uniforms and clothing.

Code/Sizes are:

**Hat Box**

HATBOX - 450 x 450 x 300m



Shoe boxes have become popular in recent years, particularly the transparent variety. For long term storage the dove grey A4 Type 1 Box may be used. It is easier to label and it restricts light.

Codes/Sizes are:

**A4 Type 1 Box**

TYPE!PA4 - 340 x 260 x150mm



For the storage of larger items, or quantities, the ALBOX and Archive boxes are ideal. Boxes are strong and stackable, easy to dismantle or assemble. Colours are: red, blue, yellow and grey

Codes/Sizes are:

**50 LITRE Archive Box**

ARCHIVEBOX – 385 x 385 x 335mm

**55 LITRE Alboxes**

ALBOX – 385 x 385 x 385mm
